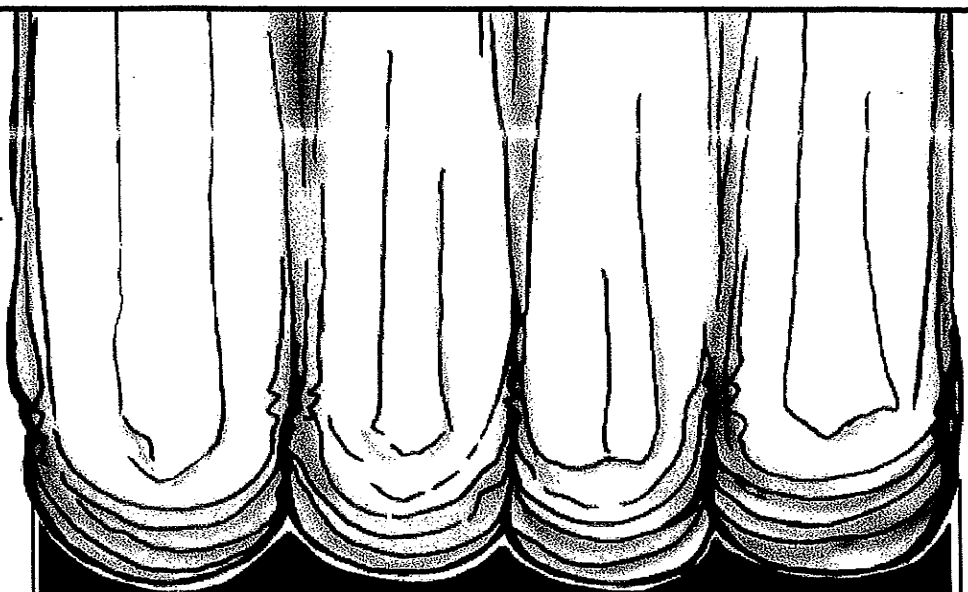


How to make an **AUSTRIAN BLIND**



Using our Austrian Ring Tape CT301

Create a beautiful life.

STEP 1

Hem (approx. 2cm) the base, sides, and top of the blind to desired width and length. *You may wish to allow a longer drop as there is always a gathered effect at the base of an Austrian (approx. 50cm).*

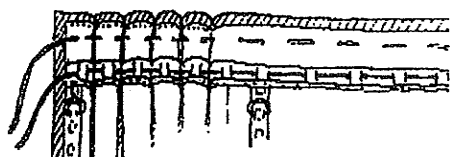
STEP 2

Attach heading tape to the top of the blind to form heading. Usually used with a pencil pleat heading tape (eg. CT748).

STEP 3

Sew tapes evenly across the width of the blind approx. 30cm apart for a scalloped effect. Wider for a swag-like effect. Make sure all tapes are lined up so rings will align across width.

Gather evenly

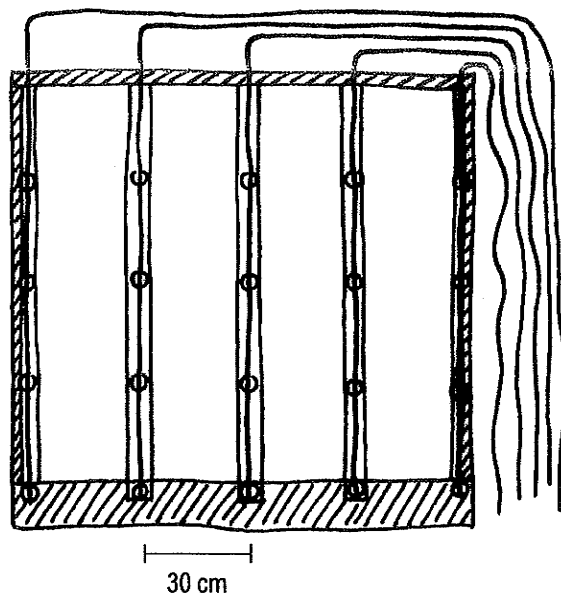


STEP 4

Draw up heading tape to required width.

STEP 5

Thread cords directly through rings. Tie off bottom of cord in ring on hem.



STEP 6

Attach to soft shade track according to track instructions.

STEP 7

After setting curtain into closed position, knot cords together then plait remaining cords. Use barrel or trumpet to give finishing touch.

STEP 8

Attach cleat to architrave.
